

Continuing our series, *Ponte Alto Profiles*, where we put a spotlight on some of the people that make up the grand Barony of Ponte Alto, we follow up with a profile of our new warlord, Marie-Therese Normand. We hope you enjoy reading!

## **Profile: Marie-Therese Normand**

**Who are you?**



Oh damn you don't ask the easy questions do you? Well outside of the SCA I'm Mary Bowles, a desktop publisher, graphic artist living in the Alexandria, Va. I'm 51 years old, I travel a lot up and down the east coast and can't keep pets because of both my job and hobby, but wish I could. I live on my own. Have very little free time and try to keep in touch with my friends, both old and new, on a regular basis.

I've been an SCA member (paid & unpaid) for a little over thirty years and a fighter for twenty-six of those 30-ish years. I collect arts and crafts and martial arts like most people collect stamps because I like understanding them. A craft shows you something of history, as well as, the craftsman's thought process and that intrigues me.

I have a Senior Brown belt in Tae Kwon Do, I know the basics of stick fighting, bokken, fencing, archery, ballista use, strategy / tac-

tics, and paint balling.

I've traveled in Europe and the near east and look forward to doing so again. I write fiction when I've got the time and hope to one day publish. I played role-playing games in my youth (D&D, White Wolf, Cyber Punk, etc.) I have family all over the central Virginia area and know one day I'll drop dead of a heart attack or stroke so I try to keep in shape. My favorite color is not red, or white, it's sky blue. I hate (sorry people) country music

because it seems whiny, but I love heavy metal and alternative for its driving beat. I also love playing Pokemon Go and finding out about new things, whether they're an art form or a friend's. I'm a book geek and a people pusher. When my friends advance I'm happy for them. I like seeing the joy on their faces after all the effort they've put into something. As for me I'm not that focused. I'm still amazed I've stayed with the SCA for thirtysomething years, and wonder how I did it.

**How did you find the SCA?**

At Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia through a group called Mead, which had connections and coexisted with the SCA through the college of Yarn Vid. Like most I saw people in armor fighting in the Commons where they held their weekly practice, I spoke to a few, and they handed me a sword showing me how to throw a flat snap and I was hooked.

**What hooked you?**

Fighting and the romance of the middle ages.

**What is the SCA to you?**

I've heard people say they found the SCA and it made them feel like a part of something that had been missing was found. That was true for me. As a delicate child for most of my youth I was always considered the one picked last for soccer or kick the can. The one that sat and watched the games rather than participate. The SCA opened a door into a world of make believe and creativity that I ran through. SCA people encouraged rather than scoffed at new ideas. They let you be as outlandish or goofy as possible and no one mocked you for it. The SCA for me is acceptance, wonder, creativity, support and family all rolled into one. That's why I like the SCA.

**Tell us about your persona.**

Baroness Marie-Therese Normand is a 13th-14th century woman caught up in the turmoil of the time that turned to fighting as a way to make a living and stay safe. She has no lord, no real family other than those made at tournaments or events. She travels with her fighting career and has guarded caravans, traveled and fought along the trade routes of Mercia, Russia, Damascus, Germany, and Spain in her wanderings. Not an easy life, but

the one she chose when her family was lost to her. She is originally Norman but during her grand-father's time Normandy became a French holding and the Normand family became no better than merchant class servants. High taxes, political enemies and just plain ill-luck got her family either killed or exiled. In her youth she almost married but that fell through when the ruin of her family (no money) was discovered. The one true thing she learned during her struggles was how to swing a sword and protect herself. That skill has kept her alive and fed until she settled in the Italian barony of Ponte Alto. From here she has move out into other Kingdoms seeking training/knowledge, tournaments, and possible riches in her martial and non-martial arts. Her current situation is that of Warlord of Ponte Alto, the responsibility was given to her by the Baron and Baroness after many years of training with the barony's troops, going to war and fighting under the barony's banner. She's led troops on the field in large wars, documented baronial goings on, held the keys to barony and has trained and overseen the martial training of the barony's troops.

### **Current/Next Project?**

Various tunics and armor repairs. I haven't really had time to sit down and focus on creating anything. I have a pair of quilted pants in the works. Armored legs (plastic), a historic quilt, various needle lace ideas, and heraldic tunics.

### **Favorite SCA event (and why)?**

Caer Mear's Gem (Diamond, Sapphire, Emerald, Ruby) Joust, because it was where I first authorized. It will always hold a special place in my heart because that's where I officially became an Atlantian fighter. Not just a girl that went to practice and got hit by the guys.

### **How do you stay busy at events?**

Fighting, marshalling occasionally, talking/teaching other fighters, promoting local events and cheering for my team/teammates. I'm a fighter at heart and that takes up a great deal of time.

### **What activity do you not do, that you'd like/plan to try?**

Target Archery. Silk painting. MOL, Baroness. :)

### **What advice would you offer someone just getting started?**

Try everything! And I mean everything, from cooking to cleaning to archeological digs to president of the SCA. Try everything and then settle into what YOU like. Without exploring other aspects of the SCA you can become bored, however by exploring every aspect there is always someone of something new to find. :)

Also, you CAN tell people you've heard enough, when they go on and on about their favorite subject. We all know we talk too much when it comes to our favorite subjects.

Otherwise have fun. Just have fun. That's really all the SCA is here for, to encourage and educate in a fun way.

### **What plans do you have as warlord/what do you see as your role as warlord?**

So far my plans for Ponte Alto entail recruiting more fighters, water bearers, MOLs and other members of the barony, and getting everyone involved in the wars to some extent, not just fighting. I want to start melee practices on Sunday early and then tourney fighting in the afternoon to grow our local melee contingent. Also, I would like to update, inventory, and supplement Ponte Alto's armory with armor for all sizes.

On a Kingdom level, I want to see University have a tract for Heavy Fighters that equals what I see in the fencing community. I want courses in Marshal 101 and 102, Melee tactics and training, Triads attack and defense, Pole Weapon training, Spear training, Small Unit, Shield Wall training, Large Unit, War Planning and Scenarios that explain Large Unit formation, planning, and engagement. AND I want these classes taught at every university, Old School War Practice, and Assessment, as well as in the winter months when we're at our lowest numbers. At the same time I also want to get patterns out in circulation to every marshal and warlord to distribute for easy to make medieval looking armor, tunics, and pants, because the initial armor investment can sometimes be too expensive for the casually interested person to buy and start fighting in, but sports gear covered in a tunic and pants could just net us one more person.

After that, we'll see what else needs to be done.




